I SPY IN THE CHURCHYARD

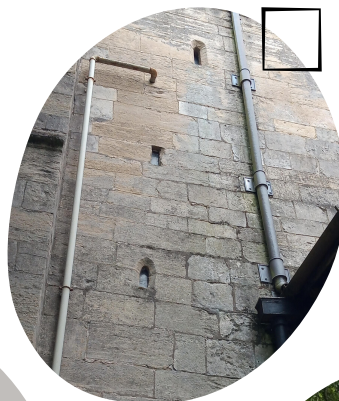
There's so many interesting things to spot in the churchyard here at St Lawrence in Hatfield. How many can you find?

DID YOU KNOW?

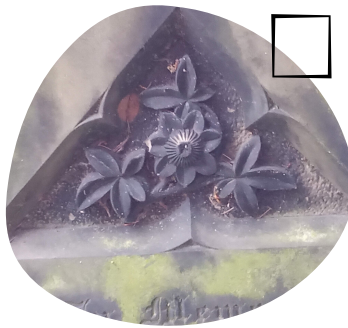
There are 8 bells inside the tower.

This tiny door is called the "Devil's Door" and used to be left open during baptisms so that any evil spirits could be easily sent out of the church

Gravestones often contained rhymes and warnings to those who read them. They might have symbols or patterns that were significant to the person on them too, such as these in our churchyard. Can you find them all?
